



## *Daytona International Speedway Race Report*

### **Richard Petty Motorsports results:**

- 10th — Elliott Sadler — Stanley Dodge
  - 15th — Kasey Kahne — Budweiser Dodge
  - 17th — AJ Allmendinger — Paralyzed Veterans of America Dodge
  - 33rd — Reed Sorenson — Air Force Dodge
- Tony Stewart made contact with Kyle Busch triggering a massive accident in the final corner of the race.
  - Stewart earned the victory with Jimmie Johnson, Denny Hamlin, Carl Edwards and Kurt Busch rounding out top five.
  - Rain cancelled Friday qualifying forcing NASCAR to set the starting lineup by owner points.
  - Richard Petty led the field on the pace laps in a replica car celebrating the 25th anniversary of his 200th victory.
  - Next race is Saturday at Chicagoland Speedway. TNT and MRN will broadcast the race at 8 pm.

### **AJ ALLMENDINGER N**

- Allmendinger started 30th and finished 17th
- Allmendinger ran with the leaders most of the race.
- With x laps remaining another car squeezed Allmendinger into the wall causing right side damage.
- He dropped from 13th to 27th in the field with four laps remaining.
- Coming to the checkered flag, Allmendinger clipped a sliding Kasey Kahne and slammed into the wall.
- He was ok, but sore after checking out of the infield care center.
- Allmendinger is 29th in points.

ALLMENDINGER: "It was a pretty hard hit. I'm okay, but I'm going to be sore tomorrow. I'm pretty disappointed we got put in the wall by another car and got put back in that mess and finished with a tore up racecar. I thought we were going to have a great finish for the Paralyzed Veterans of America on the Fourth of July."
